Students in grades Primary to 6 will receive 3 half-hour periods of music instruction per cycle. All students will study musical elements of rhythm, meter and tempo, melody and pitch, texture and harmony, form, expression and diverse cultures with increasing complexity and understanding expected in each grade.
