- Work collaboratively and independently while using time efficiently














#### Assessment

Assessment takes place on a daily basis and is a key part of the learning/teaching process. Ongoing assessment of student learning informs students about what they have learned and what they have not yet learned.

Students will be provided with a variety of opportunities and ways to demonstrate their learning and understanding in relation to the curriculum (learning outcomes) for the subject/course. Student learning will be assessed using:

- Conversations with students
- Observations of learning
- Products students create to show their learning throughout the process


Report cards are provided to students/parents three times a year communicating student learning and development of social skills and work habits.

Divided into three main components:


- <u>Speaking and Listening</u> this is carried out through:
  - Sharing Circles
  - Show and Tell
  - Class Discussions
  - Group Discussions
- Reading and Viewing this is carried out through:
  - Independent Reading (material at each student's level "just-right" books)
  - Shared Reading (whole group instruction teacher and students read)
  - Guided Reading (small group instruction)
  - Read Aloud (teacher reads to students)
- Writing and other ways of Representing this is carried out through:
  - Writer's Workshop
  - Reading Responses
  - Journals
  - Word Study
